






## "SYMBOL OF EXCELLENCE"

Employees and management of the Bradley plant of Roper Outdoor Products Group were honored today by Sears, Roebuck & Company. The Bradley plant makes Garden Tractors attachments and Tillers for Sears.

Jay Lasseigne, Sears National Garden Tractor buyer and Ed Wilk, Sears National Tiller buyer, both of Chicago, presented Sears "SYMBOL OF EXCEL-Chicago, presented Sears "SYMBOL OF EXCEL-LENCE" plaques during a dinner held at the Holicay Inn the evening of October 19, 1977. The plaques were accepted by Robert N. Patterson, President of Roper Outdoor Products Group on behalf of the entire plant personnel.

The awards were two of 592 Sears is presenting this year to suppliers judged most outstanding among it's 12,000 merchandising sources. The Bradley plant has previously received these awards in 1966, 1967, 1968 and 1969. "This award is based primarily on the excellence of merchandise produced by Roper Outdoor Products for Sears in 1976," Wilk said.

"It also recognizes the general excellence of the Bradley plants performance in such matters as shipping goods on schedule, and initiative in developing new and improved merchandise," he added

"This award is our salute to those suppliers who have through their excellence, made significant contributions to Sears reputation for quality merchandise. It also recognizes each employee for his contribution to the superior performance of the plant" said Lasseigne.

Lasseigne said Roper Outdoor Products, Bradley, was selected for the Sears "Symbol of Excellence" by a committee representing the company's retail stores, catalog plants, national service department, quality control personnel and merchandise development and testing laboratory. The committee screened nominations from Sears' 50 national buying departments.

The Bradley plant of Roper Outdoor Products group manufactures a full line of Garden Tractors and Attachments as well as an 8 h.p. Tiller for Sears. The plant employs 915 people and has been a Sears source for 82 years.
